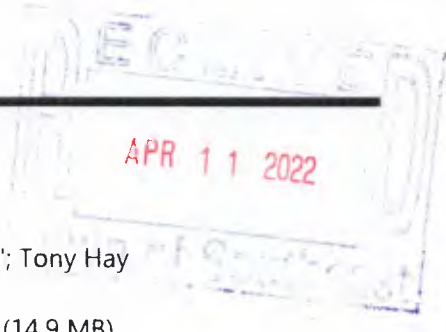

I truly am at a loss for words. I always thought that the relationship between Southeast and Patterson was a good one. I further thought I had a good relationship with the town of Southeast dating back to when the open space was first acquired and Tony Haye was kind enough to drop off the scope of the land one evening at my house. I couldn't have been more wrong.

Pugsley Road has always been an issue and Southeast has done nothing to maintain it. The years of closure where there was no turn around for the ignorant drivers that ignored the ROAD CLOSED SIGNS and the noise, lights and inconvenience I suffered with the numerous cars turning around in my driveway. Or those that chose to ignore the signs and would not only race through that area but get stuck prompting tow trucks, police or other vehicle activity, let's not forget there losing control and spinning out on my lawn? ONLY last year was there some decency with the new highway supervisor placing the concrete barrier and proper signage throughout the road. The new turn around allowed for those ignorant drivers to turn around somewhere else than my driveway. You have been terrible neighbors, and this is just another example. I am extremely upset and should not as a Putnam County taxpayer be suffering like this. I know you do not care that I am a Patterson tax payer but I am 5 ft from your line and should be treated with more respect. I take pride in my property and as my neighbor you should be more considerate. This season I have never suffered such water damage, between the ruts in front of my driveway and my driveway itself. I have had to call Patterson out numerous times to save damage to my vehicles as the valley you have created with the runoff makes it near impossible to enter my driveway without bottoming out.

This is a direct result of water damage running down from Southeast, the areas that have been cleared appear to offer no drainage. I am not sure what is going on but I was just advised by one of the Southeast workers that the trap (and I think there is only one) up there is clogged and when Patterson offered to assist in cleaning it he stated it was clogged back through the pipe. Why was the drainage not considered by the town or by the project? This has been going on for months. Only by sheer chance that I went out was I able to witness this and see it all the way up to where the project is, water running both ways down to Route 312 and down to Fields Comer.

Thank you Victoria for the layout but I do not see where the area that was cleared across from Barrett Road is?(picture enclosed in my follow-up email as I am sending you too many at once.). I do not believe that was ever listed or addressed to have trees taken down on the right side of Pugsley only the left where the project is, that is also part of the problem as well as the area that Proswing entered for testing and the numerous trees they took down and cut up. (picture enclosed), not just brush there is a water pooling where they entered.

Let me also place you on notice for the Proswing layout. As it stands now, I have drains on that side of the property due to the runoff that occurred from that side of the property and I have no water issue. It is a slope. Should there be an increase in the runoff effecting my property I would fully expect this to be prevented/remediated./addressed. This would include but not limited to the scoping process as I know the project allegedly has not been approved. This is also the importance of keeping as many trees as a boundary between the properties.
